

Wimbledon and Putney Commons Conservators

Application for Amendments of Byelaws

Notice is hereby given that the Wimbledon and Putney Commons Conservators intend after the expiry of the period mentioned below to apply to the Secretary of State for confirmation of the introduction of new byelaws made by the Board pursuant to powers contained in section 84 of the 1871 Act.

New Byelaw – Byelaw 8

No owner or person in charge of or responsible for a dog shall allow that dog to cause any annoyance, disturbance, inconvenience or injury to, or in any way to intimidate, any other person using or frequenting the Commons.

Byelaw Amendment – Byelaw 10

It shall be lawful for the Conservators from time to time to designate any part or parts of The Plain (The Plain is adjacent to Windmill Road and is identified on a plan held at the Ranger's Office) where dogs are to be temporarily excluded to prevent them from chasing ground-nesting birds during the nesting season and no person in charge of any dog on the Commons (other than a registered blind person) shall allow that dog to enter any part or parts of The Plain so designated.

Current byelaws 8 - 56 be re-numbered 9 - 57

Copies of the byelaws will be kept at the office of the Conservators at the Ranger's Office, Windmill Road, London, SW19 5NR and will be open to inspection without payment on any week day during the usual office hours for one calendar month from and after the date of the publication of this notice. Copies of the byelaws will also be supplied on receipt of an application (accompanied by a fee of £1.00 for each copy). They can also be viewed on-line at www.wpcc.org.uk
