Wimbledon and Putney Commons Conservators

Former Putney Hospital – Retrospective Valuation

November 2016

On Friday, 11th November, the Conservators received the Retrospective Valuation Report (RVR) prepared by Daniel Watney LLP, which had been commissioned in accordance with the Board's resolution following its meeting on 10th October. The receipt of the RVR marks the completion of the second stage of the Charity Commission's October 2015 Formal Action Plan.

The RVR is currently being considered by charity lawyers Charles Russell Speechlys LLP, who are advising and guiding the Board. The Board will meet on the 28th November 2016 to consider this advice and guidance and to decide on the management of the next stages of the Formal Action Plan.

The Statutory Inquiry into the Charity, opened in August 2016, continues. There is nothing further to report on this matter at this time.
