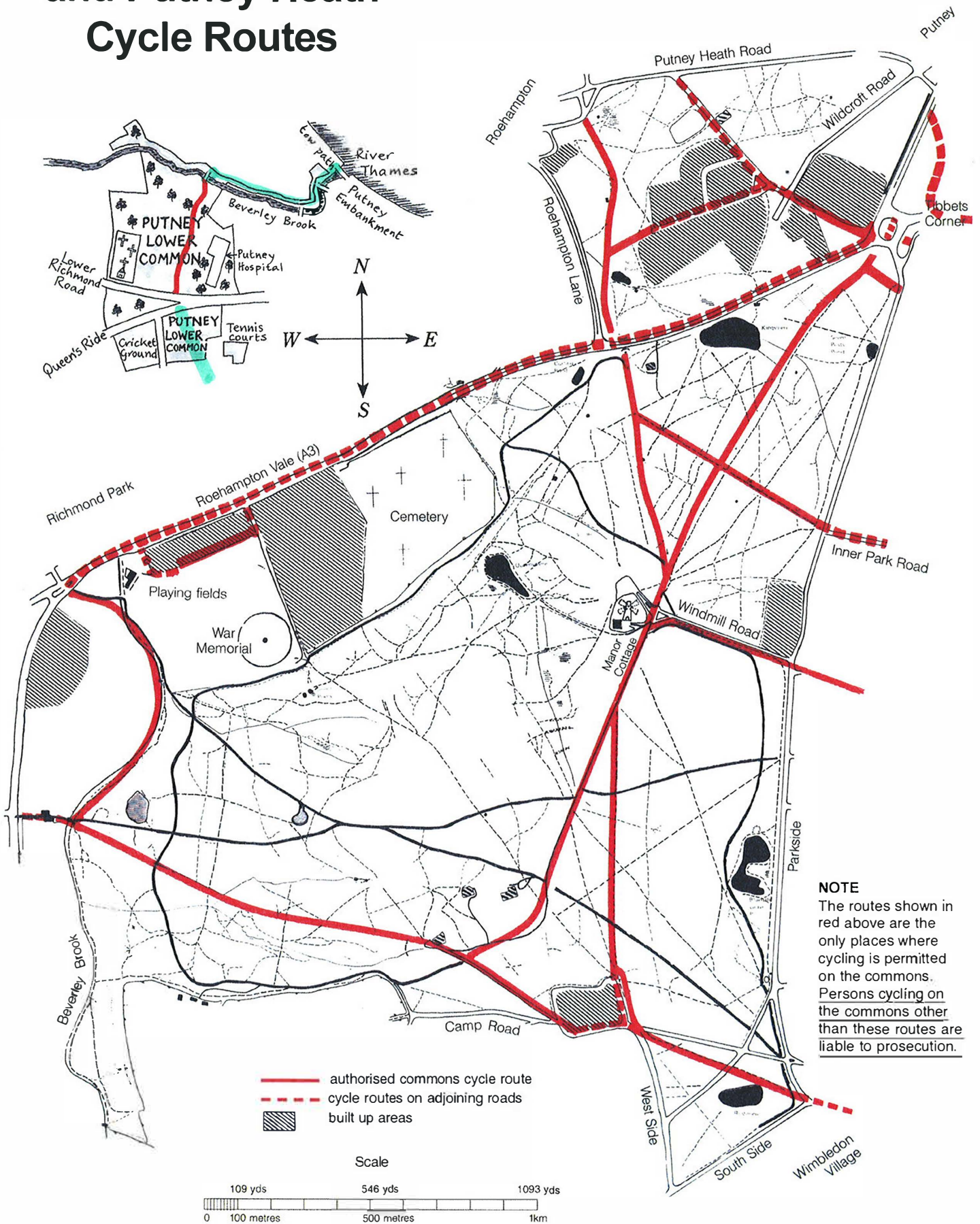


Wimbledon Common and Putney Heath Cycle Routes



NOTE
The routes shown in red above are the only places where cycling is permitted on the commons. Persons cycling on the commons other than these routes are liable to prosecution.

To avoid damage to the Commons and danger to other users, cycling is permitted only on certain routes.

Your attention is drawn to Bye-Law No.14 which states:

“Except upon roads, cycle paths or parking spaces prescribed for the purpose by the Conservators, no unauthorised person shall draw, drive, ride, stand or place any wagon, van, cart, carriage, truck, bicycle, tricycle, motor car or other vehicle upon the Commons including the footpaths or horse rides traversing the same.”

**PERSISTENT OFFENDERS
WILL BE PROSECUTED**

The enclosed map shows details of routes where Cycling is permitted. These routes are marked with the blue ‘Cycle Route’ sign as seen on the front cover which are fixed to posts along the routes.

Anyone using the Commons must always give consideration to other users and you are advised that these routes are **NOT** exclusive to cyclists and that priority must at all times be given to pedestrians and cycling speed must be controlled

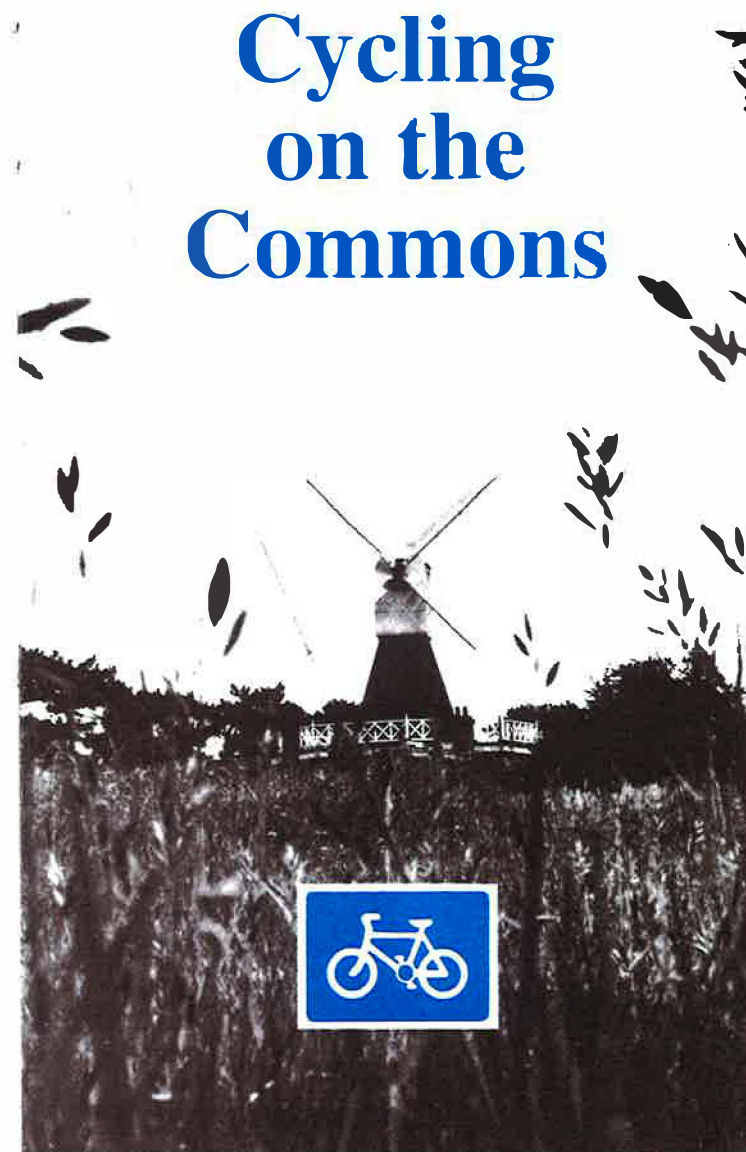
Some routes also cross over or double-up as horse rides and in such cases priority must be given to horses in the interests of safety.
